Governed by New Brunswick Elections Act

Where any election officer is by the Act authorized or required to give a public notice and no special mode of notification is indicated, the notice may be by advertisement, placard, handbill or otherwise as he considers will best effect the intended purpose.

Further guidelines concerning advertising are not outlined in the Act
